Complete Issues Online	This is a place where you can easily find articles, statistics, personal accounts and websites to help you quickly understand current issues.
Gale Cengage Learning	This is a collection of databases giving access to a wide range of resources:
- <u>Gale Virtual</u> <u>Reference Library</u> (GVRL)	Collection of specialised reference sources for multidisciplinary research.
- General OneFile	Database of 13, 000 journals and 120 million full-text articles dating from 1980 to present.
- JISC FE Custom News	Database which contains over 25 million full text articles from over 200 worldwide newspapers
JISC Media Plus	Provides online delivery of audio clips, images, and films for all curriculum areas
The Vogue Archive	Contains the entire run of Vogue magazine (US edition), from the first issue in 1892 to the current month.

Brill Online Books and Journals	Provides free online access to over 50, 000 articles.
British Periodicals (1681- 1937)	Provides access to searchable full text periodical articles.
Cambridge Core	Limited access to Cambridge University Press publications.
Historical Texts	Access to full text Historical British books from 1475 to 1900.
Periodicals Archive Online	Access to back files of scholarly periodicals in the arts, humanities and social sciences.

<u>Stock Vault</u> – Stock photo sharing site where photographers and designers can meet to share their images. Over 10,000 stock images available.
