Comprising ABI/Inform Global, Trade & Industry, Dateline and Archive. Features journals, dissertations, newspapers and country and industry focused reports.
<a href="#">COBRA (Complete Business Reference Advisor)</a>	Factsheets and reports on all aspects of running a business.
<a href="#">Oxford Reference Online</a>	Search language and subject reference works from one of the world's most trusted resources.
